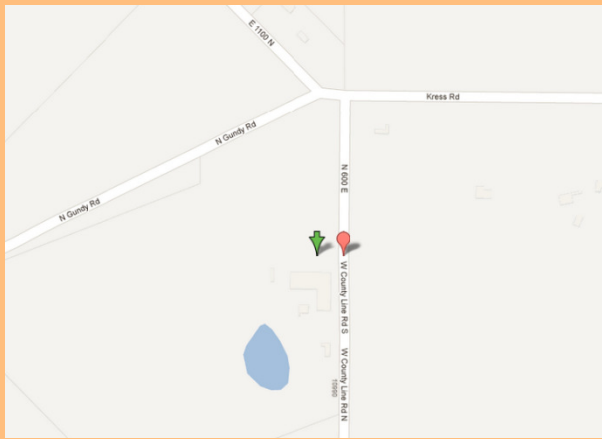
Our Services
